Social Media Bullying Examples

Online bullying can occur on sites with easy sign-up, peer-to-peer messaging, comment sections or forums, and image or video posting platforms. Examples include messaging apps, group chats, and major social platforms.

Website Requirements

Fusion Charter's website must prominently post policies and resources on suicide prevention, discrimination and harassment based on sex, Title IX information, sexual harassment policy, hate violence prevention, anti-bullying including cyberbullying, and a link to statewide resources.
